Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide unwashed fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

1-1/2 yds	Blue Hydrangeas (Y0653-30)
3/4 yd	Cream Butterflies (Y0651-2)
3/4 yd	Blue Tonal (Y0650-30)
1/2 yd	Cream Hydrangeas (Y0653-2)
3/4 yd	Cream Tiny Flowers (Y0654-2)
5/8 yd	Green Tiny Flowers (Y0654-24)
3/8 yd	Blue Butterflies (Y0651-30)
5/8 yd	Purple Tonal (Y0650-27)
4 yds	Backing of choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From Blue Hydrangeas cut:

- 1 - 8-1/2" square
- 6 - 6-1/2" x WOF strips (outer border)
- 4 - 8-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

From Cream Butterflies cut:

- 5 - 4-1/2" x WOF strips (middle border)

From Blue Tonal cut:

- 4 - 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles
- 8 - 4-1/2" squares
- 5 - 2-1/2" x WOF strips (inner border)

From Cream Hydrangeas cut:

- 8 - 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles
- 8 - 4-1/2" squares

From Cream Tiny Flowers cut:

- 12 - 4-7/8" squares
- 4 - 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles
- 16 - 4-1/2" squares

From Green Tiny Flowers cut:

- 12 - 4-7/8" squares
- 4 - 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles
- 8 - 4-1/2" squares

From Blue Butterflies cut:

- 16 - 4-1/2" squares

From Purple Tonal cut:

- 7 - 2-1/2" x WOF strips (binding)

Half Square Triangles

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a Cream Tiny Floral 4-7/8" square and layer right sides together with a Green Tiny Floral 4-7/8" square. Sew with a scant 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line (Diagram A). Cut on the drawn line and press open.
2. Repeat Step 1 to make a total of 24 pieced squares. They should measure 4-1/2" square.

Flying geese

1. Place a 4-1/2" Cream Tiny Floral square right sides together on one end of a Blue Hydrangea 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Draw a pencil line from one corner to the opposite corner of the square (Diagram B). Sew on the line. Trim the corner to 1/4" seam allowance. Press the corner out. Place another square on the other end (Diagram C). Mark, sew, trim and press. Use four Blue Hydrangea 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles with eight Cream Tiny Floral 4-1/2" squares to make four (total) 4-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch flying geese units.
2. Use Blue Tonal rectangles with Cream Tiny Floral squares to make four flying geese.
3. Use Cream Tiny Floral rectangles with Green Tiny Floral squares to make four flying geese.
4. Use Green Tiny Floral rectangles with Blue Tonal squares to make four flying geese.

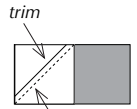

Assemble the quilt

1. Lay out the pieced squares and flying geese with the remaining squares and rectangles as shown in the assembly diagram. Sew the pieces of each row together in order. Press seams to one side.
2. Continue assembling the rows, pressing seams in alternate directions.
3. Assemble rows as shown (Diagram D).

Borders

1. First Border: Sew the Blue Tonal inner border strips together end to end. Measure the quilt across the center at the top, middle and bottom. Using the average of that measurement cut the top and bottom strips. Laying the border and quilt on a flat surface, pin the border on before sewing to ensure a flat border. Press seams toward the borders. Measure through the center from the top to bottom (similar to above); then cut, pin and sew on the side strips.
2. Second and third border: Follow the same directions to add the second border from Cream Butterflies and the third border from Blue Hydrangeas.

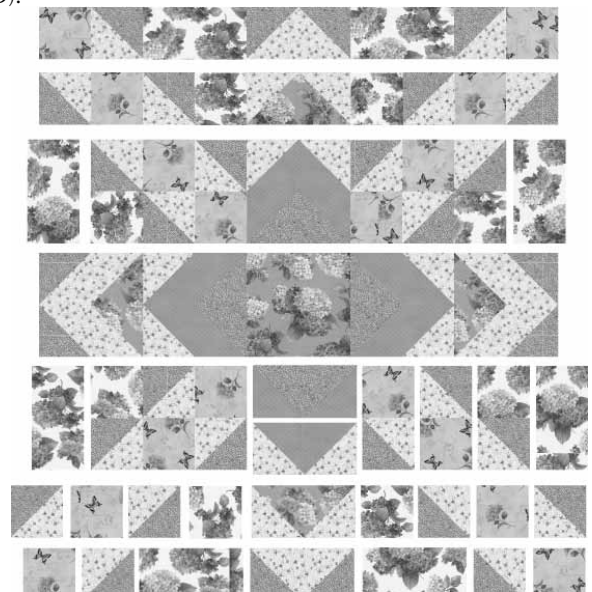
